Now when the king was settled in his house, and the Lord had given him rest from all his enemies around him, the king said to the prophet Nathan, "See now, I am living in a house of cedar, but the ark of God stays in a tent." Nathan said to the king, "Go, do all that you have in mind; for the Lord is with you."

But that same night the word of the Lord came to Nathan: Go and tell my servant David: Thus says the Lord: Are you the one to build me a house to live in? I have not lived in a house since the day I brought up the people of Israel from Egypt to this day, but I have been moving about in a tent and a tabernacle. 1 - 5-gallon bucket with resealable lid*; 4 - scouring pads; 7 - sponges, assorted sizes; 1 - scrub brush; 1 - pkg. cleaning towels (18 reusable, like Easy Wipes); 1 - 50 oz. or two 25 oz. bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent; 1 - liquid concentrated household cleaner (like Lysol) 12 oz.; 1 - 1 pkg. clothespins, 48-50; 1 - Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.; 5 - dust masks; 2 pair - heavy-duty, waterproof Dishwashing gloves (latex-free, non-surgical); 1 pair - work gloves; 1 - 24 to 28 count roll heavy-duty trash bags (30-45 gallon, remove from carton); 1 - bottle insect repellant (pump, drops or lotion; not aerosol), 6-9 oz.

Please purchase all liquids in plastic bottles. Only new, unopened materials please. *Some local fast-food restaurants are willing to give pickle buckets (or other 5-gallon buckets with resealable lids) or offer them for a small fee. These can be washed out and used for the cleanup buckets.
